The following areas require "Review" during Admission and/or Discharge Reconciliation Process

Select Admission Navigator and Admission orders activity

















- The Review tab will default for review
- In addition to reviewing current entered data, patient information from outside sources needs to also be reconciled. This outside information will appear in orange font.
- Select the orange title 'New medications from outside sources are available for reconciliation'.

- The Reconcile Outside Info Panel opens
- Information pulled into the review from outside entities are marked with this symbol: 
- Those entries with this symbol are the allergies, medications, or problems that need to be reconciled.
- There will be instances when the patient reported and imported allergies, medications, or problems are duplicate.

- Select Accept when Medication Details is completed.





- Once all imported allergies, medications, problems or Immunizations have been reconciled from the Review tab select the Mark All as Reviewed.
- The time stamp will update and show as reviewed.
